

Public Transport

The city center is 25 km from Simferopol Airport and you can get there using the buses, trolleybuses and Aeroekspres passenger shuttles that depart every 10 minutes from the airport. You pay 1 US dollar on the bus and 50 cents on the trolleybus. You can also get to the city center on the number 49, 98 and 115 city buses, which cost 25 cents, or take the number 9 trolleybus for a cost of 20 cents. The journey takes about 25 minutes.

If you are traveling on to other parts of Crimea, you can get from the airport to the cities of Alushta and Yalta using the trolleybus service that runs between Simferopol and Yalta. It costs 1.50 dollars to get to Alushta and takes 1½ hours. The journey to Yalta costs 2 dollars and takes the same amount of time. If you don't want to use the trolleybus service, there is also another bus service which runs every 30 minutes from the airport bus terminal and goes to the main cities in Crimea.

Taxi

If you don't want to waste time waiting for buses, you can get to the city center using the 24 hour taxi service that runs from the airport. The average cost of a taxi from the airport to the city center is 10 dollars and if you are traveling on to other areas, you will pay around 35–45 cents per km.
