Public Transportation (20 - 40w)

The Adolfo Suárez Madrid–Barajas Airport (MAD) is 12 km from the city center, and there's lots of ways to get there, including bus, metro taxi and train. The Exprés Aeropuerto buses run every 15 minutes until midnight and every 35 minutes after that. They pass the O'Donell, Plaza De Cibeles and Atocha bus stops, and the journey takes around 40 minutes. If you'd prefer to get to the center by metro, take a Line 8 train from the Nuevos Ministerios metro station. You may have change trains, depending on your destination.

Taxi (20 - 40w)

You'll have no problem finding a taxi outside the airport. In addition to city taxis, you'll also find a number of minicab operators too. You'll be able to tell the city taxis by the curved red lines on their doors. The journey from the airport to the city center costs around 30 euros.
